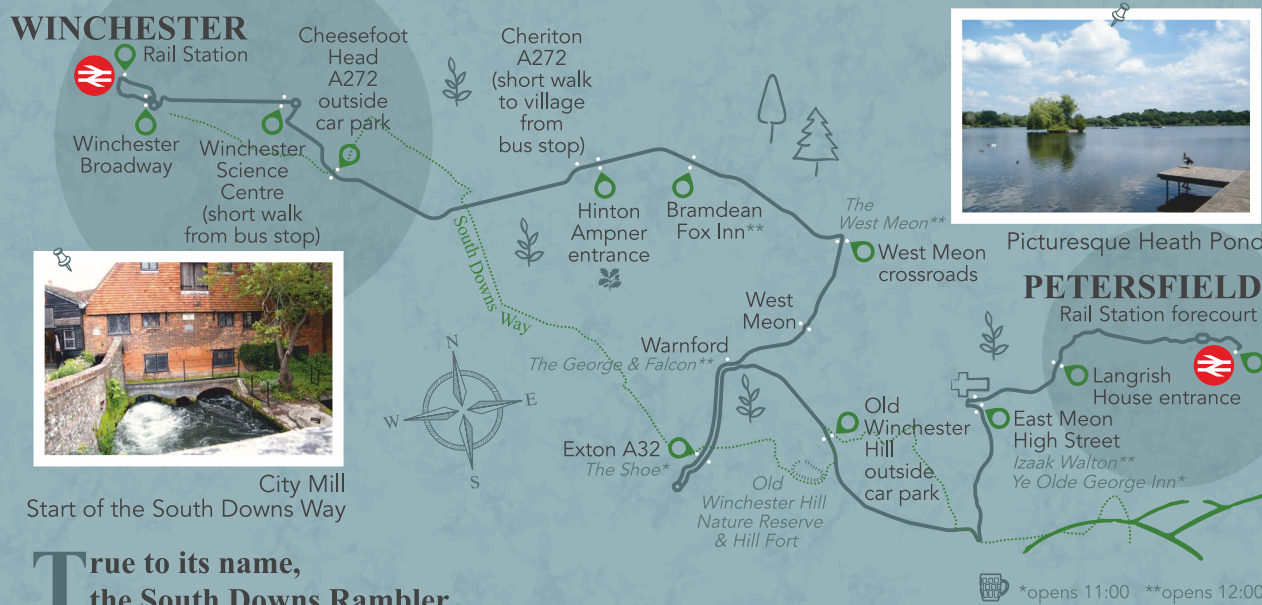

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The South Downs Rambler is a summer only bus route, funded by both Hampshire Community Rail Partnership and CrossCountry Trains, and operated by Bluestar buses, to offer visitors the chance to explore rural Hampshire in a relaxed and sustainable way.
