PlusBus

(Brighton city area stations) valid Brighton to Seaford, Chyngton Lane.

(Eastbourne) valid Golf Club-Eastbourne.

Concessionary Passes

If you are a Brighton and Hove resident

You cannot travel free in the city area on Mondays to Fridays between 0400 and 0900. If you start your journey outside the city (eg. Lewes) you cannot have free travel until 0930

Any other resident

You cannot travel free between 2300 and 0930 on Mondays to Fridays

There are no time restrictions for any passes at weekends and on Bank Holidays (valid from 0001 until midnight).

citySAVER

Accepted only between Brighton and Saltdean Bannings Vale.

East Sussex Freedom

NOTE: Credit-card style Freedom tickets not valid in school holidays.

Child Fares

- Child rate eligibility child fares will now be available to young people until the 31st August after their 18th birthday.
- Child fares are not sold on N-prefixed night buses. Child any time mobile tickets and pre-purchased child networkSAVERs are accepted.
- To pay a child fare, young people aged 14-18 may need to prove their age if they aren't in school uniform. Accepted ID for children aged 14-18 when buying child tickets on the bus: In-app child verification, Child Key BusID, UK passport, UK driving licence or Sussex 3-ID card.
- Up to four children accompanied by a fare paying adult or concessionary pass holder can travel for free for journeys wholly within the Brighton & Hove city area (excluding N-prefixed night routes).
- Up to four accompanied children can travel with a fare paying adult or concessionary pass holder, for £1 per child for journeys outside of the Brighton & Hove City area, e.g. East Sussex, West Sussex, Kent.
- Child unaccompanied fares are half the adult fare, but capped at £3 single
- The unaccompanied Child Single for journeys outside of the Brighton & Hove City area is half the adult fare.
