### Concessionary Passes

#### If you are a Brighton and Hove resident

You cannot travel free in the city area on Mondays to Fridays between 4am and 9am

If you start your journey outside the city (eg. Lewes) you cannot have free travel until 9.30am

#### Any other resident

You cannot travel free between 11pm and 9.30am on Mondays to Fridays

There are no time restrictions for any passes at weekends and on Bank Holidays (valid from 12.01am until midnight).

### East Sussex Freedom Tickets

Valid throughout these routes. NOTE: Credit-card style Freedom tickets not valid in school holidays. Children showing under-16 East Sussex 3i-D cards can obtain half fare singles or returns for journeys starting/finishing in East Sussex.
