Breeze along the prom past the Old Harbour out to Sewerby Hall, then strike inland to see Bridlington's magnificent priory church and the hidden charms of the Old Town before heading back by way of Eastfield Garden Centre.

Your ticket lasts all day, so you can hop on and off at any of the stops.

Bridlington Priory

Once one of England's great Augustinian monastic houses, double the size it is now, this imposing priory church dates from 1113AD.

After the dissolution of the monasteries under Henry VIII, what was left became a parish church. The 1889 organ was rebuilt in 2006 and is now one of the finest in the country.



Bridlington Old Town

A world away from the busy beaches, savour the undoubted charm and beguiling atmosphere of the Old Town.

There's a trail you follow to discover a number of fine heritage landmarks and stylish art galleries rubbing

shoulders with traditional pubs, tea shops, cafés and wonderful independent shops.



Bridlington Harbour

Stop off here to watch trawlers bringing their catch in, yachts of all shapes and sizes coming and going, pleasure craft bobbing about and the Yorkshire Belle and the Pirate Ship. And ice cream, fish and chip and other treats are nearby to tempt you.



Bondville Model Village

With over 200 buildings, including a castle, ruined abbey, a harbour with fishing boats and a train going round, here you can see the villagers going about their everyday lives in miniature.
