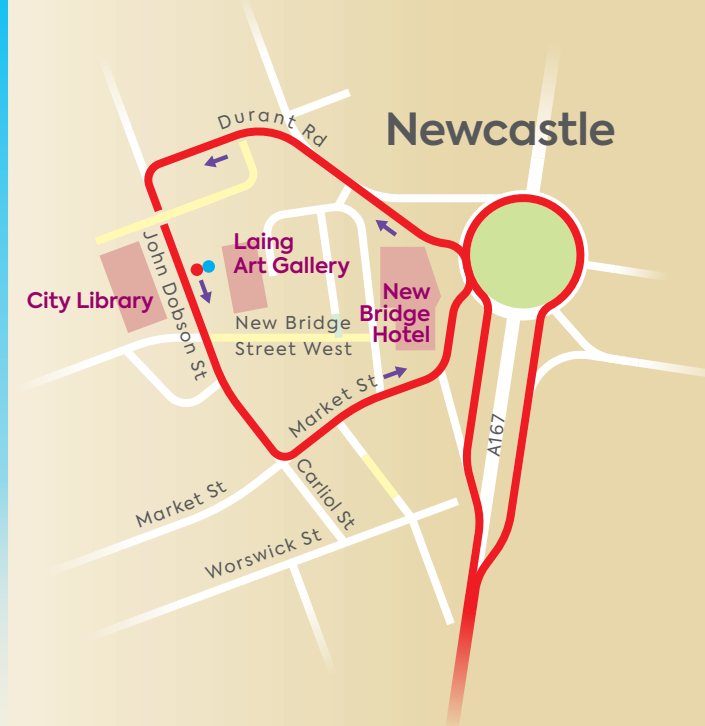

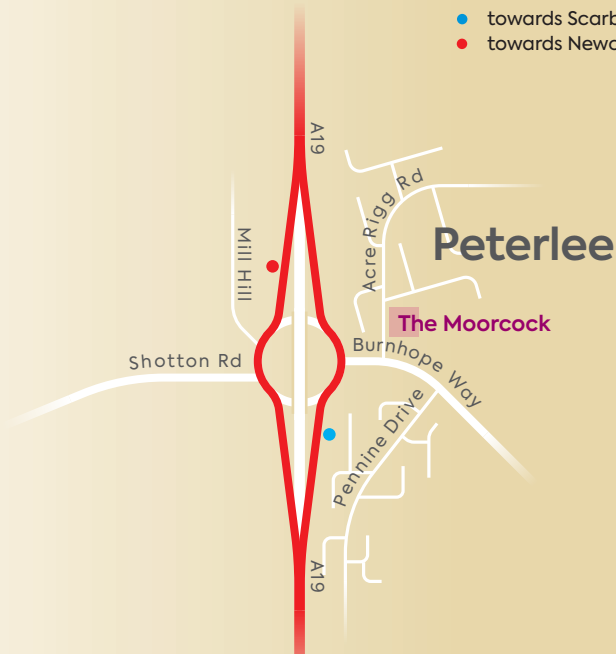

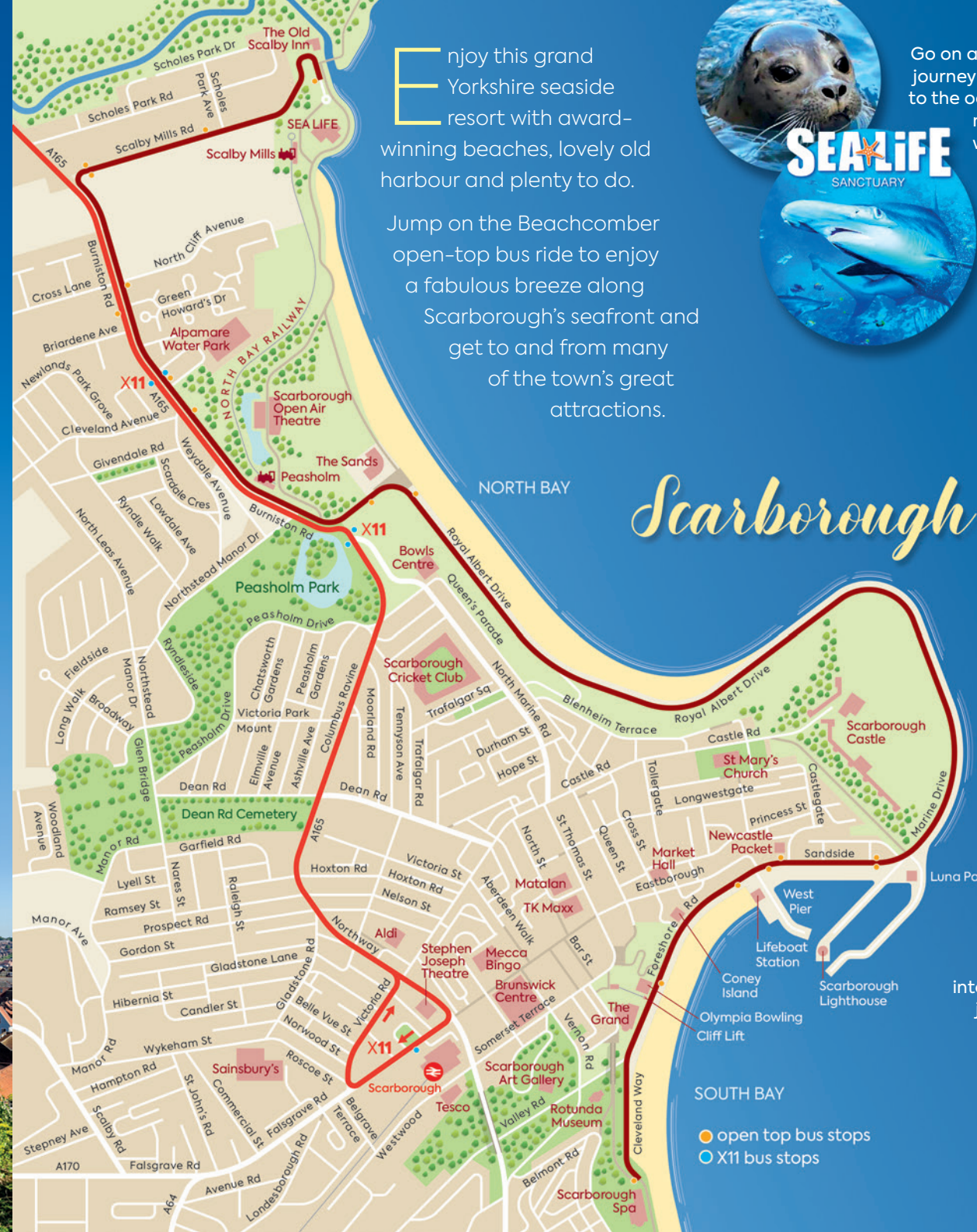
Whitby

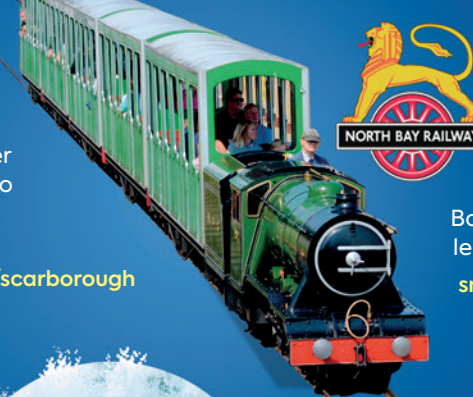
